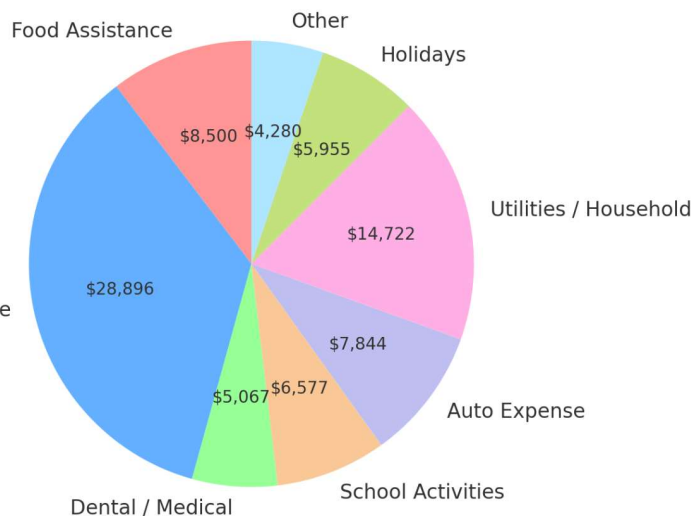
Informally established in 1999 through the initiative of his daughter, the fund grew from the vision of Dexter Keezer, a public-spirited Truro resident. It wasn't until 2002 that DKCF became an independent 501c3 nonprofit organization through the efforts of the Trustees.

In keeping with the mission of the fund, the current Trustees have developed relationships with several local organizations including the **Homeless Prevention Council, Lower Cape Outreach, Truro Council on Aging, and Helping our Women**, as well as local houses of worship and our schools who act as liaisons between those who seek assistance. Additionally, DKCF is a major supporter of the **Truro Food Pantry** and has granted funding to the **Truro Community Kitchen** since its inception in 2020.
